



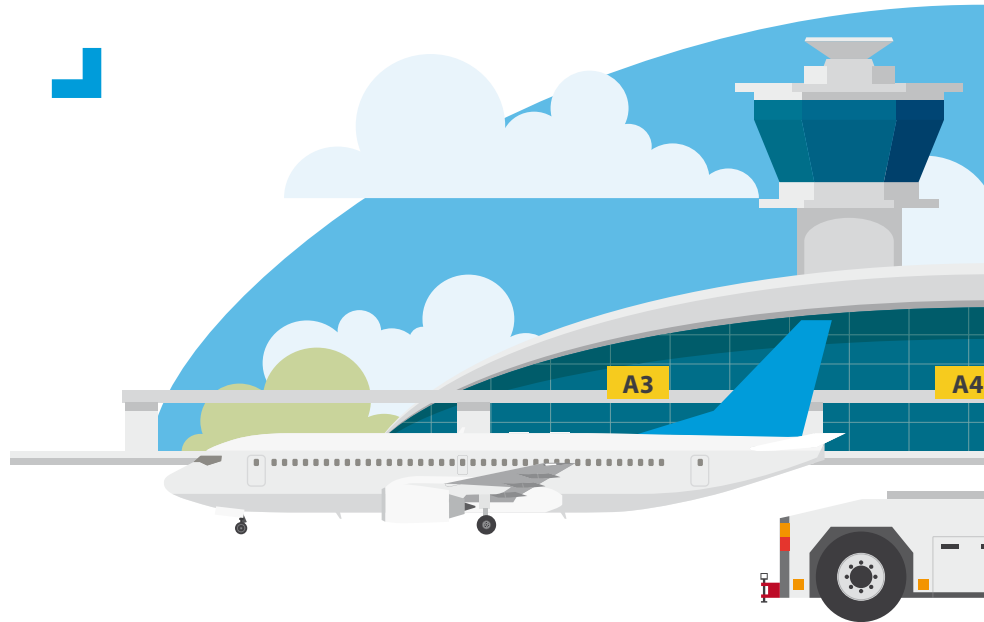

A 360° review in four simple steps



1. Pre-Survey Checklist

A pre-survey checklist designed to ensure the site review is tailored to insured's operations, and provides high level guidance on the various loss control aspects that will be reviewed.



2. Safety Survey and Site Review

A one day onsite review of the insured's environment, operations, procedures, training and human factors from a best practice loss control perspective.



3. Safety and Loss Control Report

A detailed report outlining the findings from the site survey focusing on practical and cost effective alterations the insured can take to improve the safety of their staff and minimise the potential for loss.



4. Post Survey Support

Ongoing support from the Safety and Loss Control team to help interpret the report and advise on the implementation of its findings.

Airworthiness Loss Control

A review of airworthiness operations including: maintenance scheduling, stores and supply chain quality assurance, quarantine, record keeping, maintenance procedures (if applicable) and manufacturing processes (if applicable).



Safety Management Systems:

The review will examine your SMS in order to identify the adequacy of your safety policies and procedures, safety risk management, safety assurance and safety promotion. In addition, scrutiny of your risk register will establish the efficacy of your incident/accident reporting and extant loss control measures.



Operations MRO/TSO:

The review will examine hangar/workshop facilities, quality assurance, manufacturing /repair processes and procedures, quarantine, tool control, stores and supply management and other more detailed aspects as outlined in the pre-survey checklist.



Training:

A review of staff training materials, staff training records, validation and revalidation and record keeping will be undertaken. More details in the pre-survey questionnaire.

Emergency Procedures:

A review of your local Emergency Response Plan will be undertaken to ensure it is fit for purpose and offers the best outcome for your organisation in the event of an adverse occurrence. If applicable, a review of the incident control room, facilities and checklists will also be carried out.



Health and Safety:

On site procedures, correct PPE usage, COSHH compliance, MSDS, first aid provisions including fire-fighting appliances will be reviewed. Additionally your Safe Working Practices will be reviewed to ensure best practice procedures are adopted.
